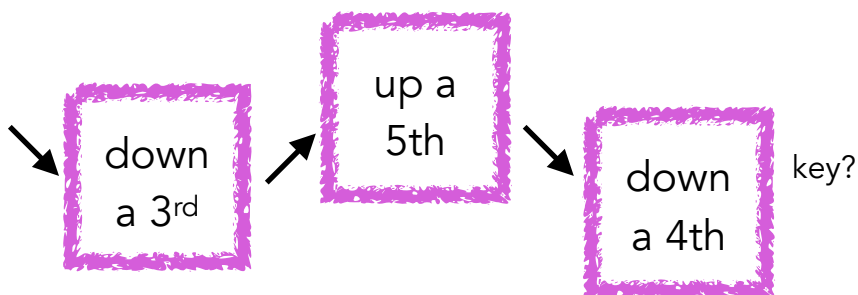


Weekly Practice

Start with RH 3 on E, play
